

Lumbar Traction & Decompression

Low back pain affects 60%–80% of the adult population, and the lumbar disk is one of the most common culprits for this condition.

Lumbar traction separates vertebral bodies and reduces compression forces on the lumbar discs. It also decreases nerve root compression by enlarging the space where spinal nerves exit the spine.
